Deposits and Payments of Final Balances

A deposit of 20% per person will be required for all tours and will be payable on booking. Bookings are not confirmed until a 20% deposit has been received. The final balance on all tours will be due 42 days (6 weeks) before departure. (Continental holidays final balances will be due 57 days (8 weeks) before departure)

Authorisation to sign the contract

The person signing the contract does so, on behalf of all members of the group and accepts these booking conditions on their behalf. It is to this person that all correspondence will be sent and, in the event of holiday cancellation or change, the company are not liable if the other members of the party are not informed.

Cancellation by the Company

The Company will not cancel a tour after the final balance due date unless it is necessary to do so by circumstances beyond our control. If it is found necessary to cancel a tour, alternatives will be offered where possible, with an opportunity to transfer at no charge or a full refund of all money paid will be sent after which all liability on part of the tour company shall cease.

Cancellation by the Passenger

Cancellations must be notified in writing and signed by the person who made the booking. All deposits are non-refundable.

The following scale of cancellation charges apply:

Prior to 42 days before departure date	Deposits only
35 to 42 days before departure date	40% or deposit (whichever is greater)
29 to 34 days before departure date	60%
