Experience the Isle of Skye and the Outer Hebrides on our fabulous tour exploring the west coast and islands. Marvel at the magnificent scenery of the Isle of Skye before crossing over to the magical islands of Harris and Lewis, steeped in Neolithic history.

Tuesday 1st October 2024

Board the coach at Highway Garage for the journey to Fort William, with comfort stops being made and a lunch stop Callendar. Arriving at the Alexandra Hotel late afternoon.

Wednesday 2nd October 2024

This morning we head to Mallaig, pausing at the famous Glenfinnan Viaduct – featured in the Harry Potter films – for a photo stop. On arrival in Mallaig, we embark on a ferry journey to Armadale, on the Isle of Skye. The

afternoon will be spent in Armadale Castle, Gardens and Museum – where we discover the castle ruins, which date from the 19th century, and the stunning gardens.

Thursday 3rd October 2024

Today we make our way to the north west corner of Skye to visit Dunvegan Castle and Gardens. Built on a rocky outcrop on the shores of Loch Dunvegan – the oldest continuously inhabited castle in Scotland. After the visit, sit back and enjoy a scenic drive around the northern Trotternish Peninsula via Duntulm.

Friday 4th October 2024

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and wave goodbye to the hotel as we make our way to Portree, the largest town on Skye. Explore the harbour area and find a spot to purchase lunch before continuing to Uig, where we will catch the afternoon ferry to Tarbert on Harris.

Saturday 5th October 2024

Today begins with a visit to the Calanais Visitor Centre and the extraordinary 5000 year old Calanais Standing Stones – one of the best preserved megalithic sites in Scotland and predating Stonehenge. Our day continues with a visit to the Gearrannan Blackhouse Village where we step back in time to experience the way of life in typical crofting township of the 19th century.

Sunday 6th October 2024

Today a local coach and guide will meet you at the hotel for a relaxing tour of the islands of Harris and Lewis, steeping in history and culture stretching back thousands of years. Travelling south to Tarbert and Isle of Scalpay, which has a population of 300 and is a compact 2.5 square miles in total. The island is connected to Harris via a single track bridge. In the afternoon we head north to the port of Ness, a picturesque fishing village with the Butt of Lewis Lighthouse marking the most northerly point on the mainland of the Isle of Lewis.

Monday 7th October 2024

Today we board the ferry to Ullapool, continuing on to our overnight stay at The Ben Wyvis Hotel, Strathpeffer.

Tuesday 8th October 2024

This morning we continue our journey, with a lunch stop being made in Pitlochry. We then make our way to our final overnight stop at The Buchanan Arms Hotel, Drymen.






